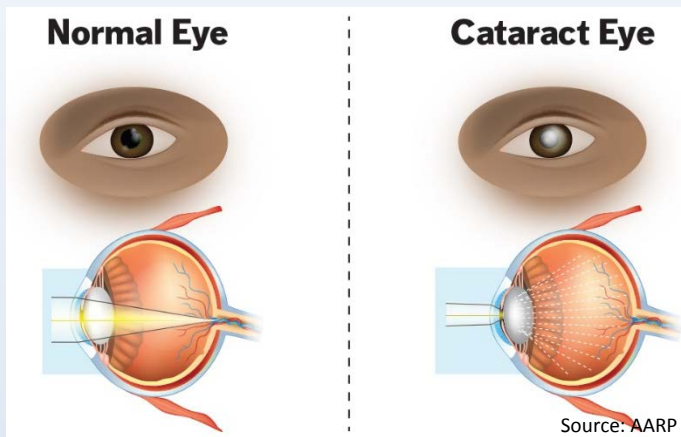

Cataracts are a clouding or loss of transparency in the lens of an eye. Protein builds up over time and affects clarity of vision; similar to how smudged glasses can distort vision. Cataracts are part of the natural aging process of the lens, but if left untreated they can lead to blindness.



Symptoms of Cataracts:

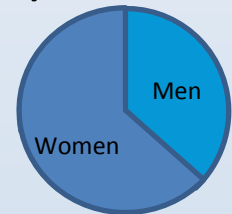
- Double/blurred vision
- Sensitivity to light and glare
- Reduced vision at night
- Milky or yellow-ish tint to vision

Causes of Cataracts:

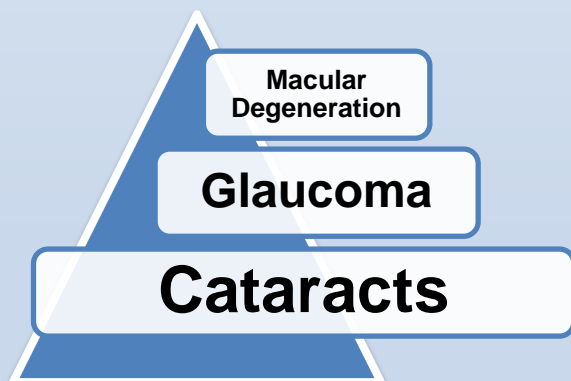
- Ultraviolet Radiation (UV Rays)
- Higher Consumption of Alcohol
- Having Diabetes Increases Risk
- Smoking Can Increase Risk
- Advanced Age Increases Likelihood
- Medications (Corticosteroids)
